**Important to note:** This change does not affect your medical coverage. That will continue with the provider you selected.





- New discount program
- Available from UnitedHealthcare

- No registration


# Mail Order Service

- UnitedHealthcare Mail Service is provided through OptumRx
- Some current mail orders automatically will transition to UnitedHealthcare
- You will receive a notice from OptumRx is your prescription transfers
- Submit new prescriptions beginning January 1, 2017 to UnitedHealthcare



# New ID Card

- Use your current ID card through December 31, 2016
- You will receive a new ID card in December
- Begin using your new ID card on January 1, 2017 (but not before!)



**Use beginning January 1, 2017**



# Other Changes

- Some drugs added and removed
  - If a drug is removed, alternatives are available
- Some drugs covered differently
  - Tiers (higher or lower)
  - Quantity limits
  - Prior authorizations
- Some changes to participating network and EDS pharmacies

# FAQs

## What is a Transition Fill?

- Drug is either not covered or ability to get drug is limited.
- Temporary supply of prescription drug
- Most commonly a 30 day supply
- Gives you time to talk to your doctor about other options


