



WHAT'S NEW FOR PLAN YEAR 2024

Note: Your Jan. 1 premium is on your Personal Benefits Enrollment Statement in this packet.

Plan administrator changes

- Jan. 1, 2024: Express Scripts Medicare® (PDP) starts HealthSelect™ Medicare Rx.
- Sept. 1, 2023: EyeMed Vision Care, LLC (EyeMed) becomes the administrator of the State of Texas Vision™ program. A new prescription drug administrator will be available in the coming months.

Why do we make plan administrator changes?

ERS is required to solicit for new administrator and to ensure the best benefits programs we offer.

We understand the changes can be inconvenient, but they are necessary—even billions—of dollars. The changes also help us to maintain appropriate costs and premiums and fees while maintaining appropriate care.

PRESCRIPTION DRUG COVERAGE

Express Scripts Medicare® (PDP) will be the administrator of the HealthSelect Medicare Rx prescription drug program starting Jan. 1, 2024. UnitedHealthcare will continue to manage the program through 2023. See the insert or visit ers.texas.gov/what-s-happening-now/healthselect-rx-transition.

Prescription drug coverage for dependents and survivors who have GBP enrolled in Medicare Part A and/or Part B through HealthSelect Medicare Rx. This plan is a preferred brand-name drug program.

Prescription drug coverage falls into three categories, called tiers, based on the type of medication. Medications, such as generic drugs, preferred brand-name drugs, and non-preferred brand-name drugs.

Express Scripts Medicare PDP will be available for HealthSelect Medicare Rx beginning Oct. 30, 2023. If you are not yet eligible for Medicare and are covered through the UnitedHealthcare Prescription Drug Program (PDP), administered by UnitedHealthcare through 2023, you will continue to be covered through 2023. See the prescription drug coverage insert for details.

Express Scripts Medicare (PDP) toll-free customer service associates will be able to answer your questions, provide information about your plan, and help you understand the covered cost of your medication.

The health plans comparison chart in this packet is an overview of medical and prescription drug coverage available to Medicare-eligible participants. For more information, read the Master Benefit Plan Documents on the plan's website. Note: Consumer Directed HealthSelect™ is not available to dependents of Medicare-eligible retirees.

Take note

You can decline HealthSelect Medicare Rx coverage. If you do, you won't have any prescription drug coverage through the GBP. A covered dependent can't decline coverage unless the eligible member who covers them also declines it.

Out-of-pocket maximums

Each year you have a yearly \$50 prescription drug out-of-pocket maximum that resets each Jan. 1.

Know your options

When you take on a long-term basis, you can choose to get your medication if you go to a retail pharmacy in the United States or a preferred Days' Supply (EDS) network pharmacy. More information about network pharmacies is available on the website. If a generic drug is available and you pay the generic copay plus the same amount for the brand-name and generic drugs.

Increases to HealthSelect MA PPO organization (MA PPO) rates

For those who pay health insurance premiums, HealthSelect MA PPO rates will increase about 5–7%. The increase is the result of rising prescription costs. Find more details about your plan in your Personal Benefits Enrollment Statement (PBES).

Despite the increase, the HealthSelect MA PPO plan was chosen in 2020, before UnitedHealthcare became the administrator, to continuous cost-management efforts by ERS. Through a competitive bidding process to select the new preferred provider organization, Express Scripts Medicare, prevented a higher increase.

Benefits to protect your health and future

The Texas Employees Group Benefits Program (GBP) offers benefits to State of Texas retirees and their eligible dependents and survivors.

If you are a retiree eligible for Medicare, Fall Enrollment is your chance to make changes to your benefit elections. Even if you're keeping your current coverage, this guide will help refresh your knowledge about your benefits. It's important to understand your health plan and other insurance choices, and your share of their cost.

Review your coverage

Review your current coverage and see what benefits options and premium rates are in your Personal Benefits Enrollment Statement included in this packet, and in your ERS OnLine account.

No changes? If you're keeping the same coverage, you don't need to do anything. Your current choices will stay the same.

Important dates

Oct. 30 – Nov. 17: Make changes to your benefits.

Benefit elections for the new plan year are effective Jan. 1, 2024.

Increases to dental HMO rates

DeltaCare® USA dental health maintenance organization (HMO) rates will increase. This is a return to Plan Year 2022 rates due to a COVID-19-related refund from DeltaCare.

Changes to out-of-pocket maximums

The HealthSelect™ Secondary health plans maximums (medical and pharmacy combined) will increase from \$7,050 and \$15,000 for 2023 to align with the IRS maximums.

Note: The Texas Legislature decides the level of funding for all GBP benefits and has no continuing obligation to provide those benefits beyond each fiscal year.

What can I do during Fall Enrollment?

During Fall Enrollment you can:

- enroll in a benefit you don't have,
- change plans or end enrollment and
- add or drop dependents.

HealthSelect Secondary
or waive coverage
anytime.



- EyeMed Vision Care, LLC (EyeMed) is the new administrator of the State of Texas Vision plan.

- Express Scripts will be the new administrator of the prescription drug programs.

Respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) vaccine and your prescription drug benefits



Medicare covers the RSV vaccine as a **prescription drug benefit**. You can use your HealthSelectSM Medicare Rx ID card at in-network pharmacies to get the vaccine at \$0 copay.

The RSV vaccine is not covered as a medical benefit through HealthSelectSM Medicare Advantage or HealthSelectSM Secondary.

Premium increases

HealthSelectSM *Medicare Advantage Plan*

- Increase of about 5 – 7%
- Still lower than premium in 2020


Effective January 1, 2024

- In-network, out-of-pocket maximums increase to \$7,500 for individual coverage and \$15,000 for family coverage.

What is an out-of-pocket maximum?

- The most you have to pay for covered services in a plan year.

Webinars about specific plans will feature an overview of the plan, followed by Q&A with the plan administrator. (Plan representatives can answer general questions. If you have a specific question about your account or a claim, contact the plan's customer service number.)

ERS Executive Director Porter Wilson and other speakers will be at Fall Enrollment fairs in the Austin, Dallas-Fort Worth and Houston areas.
